SUMMERQUEST PROGRAM: Summer camp and child care are available for children 18 months old on or before June 1 through students in Grade 6. This program begins the week after the last day of the current school year and ends two weeks before the start of the new school year. See pricing on *SummerQuest Registration Form*.

FAMILY DISCOUNT: For a family with more than one child enrolled, discounts are given as follows: 2.5% off total tuition for a family with two students, 5% off total tuition for a family with three students, 7.5% off total tuition for a family with four students, 10% off total tuition for a family with five or more students.

ENROLLMENT/REGISTRATION FEE: (non-refundable unless SCS is unable to admit the student) New families - \$250 per student for Grades EE2-K4 and \$500 per student for Grades K5-12; Current families - \$250 per student for all grades.

WITHDRAWAL POLICY: Enrollment at SCS is a commitment for the entire school year. The only accepted withdrawals from the school, to be made by a parent in the appropriate school office, are as follows:

- Parent job change or transfer to another location more than 30 miles from the campus
- Termination of enrollment due to expulsion of a student

These circumstances require a \$500 withdrawal fee per student in addition to payment based on a per diem rate for the number of days the student was enrolled.

Withdrawal per parental choice, not meeting the terms listed above, does not relieve financial responsibility for full tuition payment, as all tuition payments are non-refundable.

All outstanding bills must be paid and all textbooks and SCS materials must be returned before school records, grades, or transcripts will be released to any other school or institution.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE (for Grades K5-12): Applications are available at www.factstuitionaid.com with a deadline of April 1, 2012. Students must be accepted or enrolled prior to consideration.

TUITION AND FEES PAYMENT (non-refundable unless the family moves more than 30 miles from the campus or we are unable to admit the student):

1. Three non-refundable payment plan options are available: (a) Pre-pay all tuition in ParentsWeb before the close of business on Friday, June 1, 2012 and receive a 3% discount; (b) 10 equal monthly payments between June 1, 2012 – March 1, 2013; (c) 12 equal monthly payments June 1, 2012 – May 1, 2013.
2. Two payment methods are available: (a) Automatic Bank Draft from a checking or savings account; (b) Credit Cards - For security reasons, we are using an outside provider to store and process monthly credit cards. Due to this change, **we will no longer be able to take VISA**. You will be charged a **3.75% Service Charge** for processing each credit card payment. This means that the Service Charge amount is calculated based on 3.75% of your payment amount. The 3.75% Service Charge is added to your payment and will appear as a separate item on your credit card statement. The Service Charge is not a fee assessed by SCS. The Service Charge is not refundable, even if the payment to which it relates is cancelled, refunded, credited, or charged back.

3. Statements will be e-mailed by the 25th of each month. Drafts and credit card transactions will occur on the 5th or 20th of each month. A three-week notice is required for cancellation of either bank draft or credit card as the method of payment. If there is a disputed charge, please contact the appropriate party as soon as possible. A list of contacts is available on our website at www.southsidechristian.org. Any adjustment made will show on the next month's school bill.
4. If a payment is returned/declined, a \$35 fee will be charged to the account. Credit cards will be resubmitted for processing. Declined bank drafts will require a money order or cash payment upon notification.
5. Payment is due the first of the month and a late fee of \$35 will be assessed for any payment not made on the specified payment date. Should there be a failure to make timely payment, parents agree to pay all costs of collection to include reasonable attorney fees, regardless of whether suit is instituted. Any dispute arising between the parties shall be resolved only by a court of competent jurisdiction situated within Greenville County, South Carolina. Each party waives the right to a trial by jury with respect to any dispute arising under this agreement.
6. Parents agree that, if any payment is not made within twenty (20) days of the date due, the school may, at its option, suspend the student or refuse to accept or enroll the student. The school is under no obligation to provide educational services or activities after payment becomes past due. Also, payment of all amounts owed is required before the school will provide any certificates or diplomas or permit the student to participate in any events, activities, or ceremonies, including graduation. Further, payment of all amounts owed is required before the school will release any records or transcripts.
7. Parents agree that they have each read the above terms, that they understand the above, and that they each agree with the terms above. Parents further agree that they are jointly and severally responsible for the timely payment of all tuition, fees, and other amounts owed.
